

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION
OF THE
BROOKLYN WOMEN'S BAR ASSOCIATION, INC.

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We, the undersigned, all being persons of full age and each and all being attorneys or counsellors of the Supreme Court of New York State in active practice, residing or having our offices in Kings County, desiring to form a Bar Association, pursuant to and in conformity with an act of the legislature of the State of New York, Laws of 1909, chapter 40, article 9, entitled Membership Corporations Law, and the several acts of the said legislature amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, do hereby certify, declare, sign, acknowledge and file this certificate for that purpose, as follows:

First. The name of the proposed Bar Association is the BROOKLYN WOMEN'S BAR ASSOCIATION, INC. ()

Second. The purposes for which said association is to be formed are to cultivate the science of jurisprudence, to promote reforms in the law, to facilitate the administration of justice, to elevate the standard of integrity, honor and courtesy in the legal profession, and to cherish the spirit of sisterhood among the members thereof.

Third. The county in which the operations of the said association are to be conducted is Kings County.

Fourth. The principal office of said association is to be located in the Borough of Brooklyn, City of New York.

Fifth. The number of its directors shall be nine.
